- Econ: 0.5 credits of Personal Finance and 0.5 credits of Economics.
- Bible: 1 credit for every year as a full-time LUOA student.
- Health & PE: 2 credits including a minimum of 0.5 credits in each subject.
- Lang/FA/CTE: 2 credits of a Foreign Lang, Fine Arts, or Career & Tech electives (no more than 1 credit of lang allowed).
