OLD AND NEW TESTAMENT PRINCIPLES OF WORSHIP

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course presents principles of Old and New Testament Worship. Included is a discussion of pre-tabernacle, tabernacle, temple, and synagogue worship. An overview of how Jesus, the disciples, and the early Christians worshipped is made in light of how believers will practice Worship in eternity.

RATIONALE

To develop a comprehensive perspective of worship it is vital to first understand what the Bible says on the subject. Having explored the foundational tenets of worship in WRSP 101, students will delve deeper into scripture for a systematic evaluation. This course is designed to provide the student with an overview, general understanding and acquaintance with the: 1) Biblical principles of Old Testament worship; 2) Biblical principles of New Testament worship; 3) Principles of Worship of Jesus and the Disciples; 4) Principles of worship in the Revelation, and 5) Principles of worship as they relate to the early and contemporary church.
